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Always follow the instructions in this manual before using the device. Please keep this manual easily accessible in the vehicle for future reference.

## SAFETY INFORMATION

- In general, the assembly and installation of the device must be performed by a trained and technically skilled specialists, as the installation and connection of the device requires complex knowledge.
- This device is only suitable for the operation in a vehicle with an on-board voltage of 12 volts, negative ground.
- · Improper installation or use may void the warranty.
- Note any time the traffic regulations of the country in which the device is operated.
- Please ensure, that with the engine turned off the vehicle's battery does not discharge fully. The
  device is another electrical consumer which must be operated with the engine running, oth
  er-wise the vehicle's battery will be discharged and the vehicle can not be started.
- Set the volume of the device only as loud, that you are still be able to hear warning signals (e.g. police sirens) and traffic noise inside the vehicle.
- Operate the device as driver only if it's absolutely necessary and in the driving safety is not compromised. The same stands for looking at the screen. If necessary, better park your vehicle at a safe and appropriate location.
- The traffic rules of the EU prohibit to view moving pictures or movies while driving, if the screen
  of the device is installed within sight of the driver, as he may be distracted. View the screen as
  driver only for the navigation function, and then only briefly that you will not be distracted. Note
  at any time the local traffic regulations. In an accident, regress claims could be made by the car
  insurance company.
- This device is not a substitute for your personal judgment or perception. All suggested routes from the navigation system should never be taken as a reason to disregard the local traffic rules. Your personal assessment of traffic or your knowledge of safe driving practices is paramount. Always match your driving with the current traffic situation.
- Do not follow the suggested routes, if the navigation system instructs you to take an unsafe or illegal way, puts you in an unsafe situation, or directs you into an area which you consider unsafe.
- If problems occur while driving, park the vehicle in a safe and appropriate place to continue before you operate.
- The device supports only DVD/CD standard disk size of diameter with 12 cm. Do not attempt to
  insert disks with a different size or any other object into the disk slot. Be sure to load only one
  disk at the same time.
- Please use only the included original accessories. Ensure a sufficient mounting of the device by
  using the included installation accessories, as in the event of an accident enormous accelerations may occur. Poorly installed devices and equipment in accidents could represent a severe
  risk to the driver and the other passengers of the vehicle.
- Note under all circumstances the regulations and advice of the vehicle manufacturer and do not make any modifications to the vehicle, which could interfere with safe driving. Please treat all parts of the device and the components of your vehicle always with caution.
- Please avoid short circuits and make sure that no metal objects can get inside the device. Also
  make sure that all connections are properly connected and avoid the interchanging of the polarity
  of all connections. Complete the installation only while the ignition is turned off.
- In the event of a defect or malfunction, do not attempt to repair it by yourself or open the device,

this is dangerous and could cause injury or damage to the equipment or vehicle. A repair should be done by trained and authorized personnel only. The device uses a Class 1 laser to read the disk. Eye contact with a laser is very dangerous to the human eye.

- If you connect an external device, you should first read the instruction manual of the external device and make sure that it is compatible. Avoid connecting an incompatible external device.
- If you install external applications onto the operating system of the device or operate files, make sure that they are "virus free" and compatible with Windows CE 6. Otherwise there is a risk that the operating system no longer works properly and must be reinstalled.
- Do not damage or scratch the screen with sharp objects. Do not operate the screen with hard objects.


## NOTES FOR THE INTENDED USE

Only use the device in the area intended for it. In the event of misuse, incorrect installation or modifications, the operating permit and the warranty expire.

Do not use mini-discs or other shaped media than regular CDs / DVDs, otherwise the drive may be damaged or the media can no longer be ejected.

The CD / DVD drive has transport locks. Remove these before installation, otherwise no media can be inserted into the drive.

## FIRST STEPS

#### Before you use the device, you should save a backup copy of the navigation software on your PC.


After switching on the device for the first time, the radio interface appears.



#### How the touchscreen works

Most functions of the device are controlled via the touchscreen.

To facilitate operation, some functions and actions that you can perform on the touchscreen are indicated by icons in the instructions of this owner's manual.



You can move the screens like on a smartphone. To do this, touch the screen and slide it to the left or right.

In the system settings, you can set some basic options and settings of the device. A short touch of the box next to the caption will activate the option. A check mark 🗸 will show you that the option is selected.



If the check mark for "Handbrake" is not set, you will get the message "Attention you can not use this function while driving". Check the box if you want to watch videos.

#### Handbrake activation of the video playback while driving

- Activate the item Handbrake in the system settings

In order to avoid being distracted while driving, the playback of video files or the playback of DVB-T2 is prevented. As soon as you check off the handbrake, you will see an information screen indicating that this is not allowed while driving.

#### Brightness

There are several options for setting and controlling the brightness. This also includes the dimming function.

First of all, touch the arrow down button to the right of the menu item Auto / Manual

After you have touched the arrow, the submenu opens. Depending on the selected function, another option will be enabled in the settings.

If you select **Off**, nothing will happen when engaging reverse gear, the screen will remain in the menu you are currently in.


If you select Camera, you will see the camera image when engaging the reverse gear.

#### Front Camera Enable

If a front camera has been installed, this can be used to set how long the front camera remains switched on after leaving reverse gear.

#### Video Input

Adjust the brightness and contrast for video sources.

#### Dual zone

If you have activated the option, for example, the navigation will be displayed on the monitor of the device and a movie will be played in the passenger area.

#### Steering wheel control

If you have a multifunction steering wheel, you can assign the buttons of the steering wheel using this key. To do this, select a function on the touchscreen and then press the desired button on the steering wheel to control this function.


#### **Reset start logo**

Clicking on this button will reset the start logo (bootlogo) of the device.


#### Reset to factory settings

## MAIN MENU

The main menu is divided into three pages. You can reach the next page by pressing on the page navigation lines or by sliding. Depending on the selected user interface, the display of the functions may vary.



Touch the screen with one finger and then move it to the right or left. This will move you to each page of the main menu.



The three lines on the bottom of the display show you which menu page you are on. By a short click on the respective line, you can also go directly to the corresponding page.



#### Start the navigation

Now go to the main navigation menu or press the NAV button on the device. The first start may take a moment.

The owner's manual for the navigation software can be downloaded from our website **www.esxnavi.de** in the download area.



#### Carry out map update

To perform a map update, you need to download software from the navigation software vendor. The software (Naviextras Toolbox) can be found for free at **www.naviextras.com**.

#### Navi Path

If the navigation does not start or you want to use the device with another compatible navigation software, you can set the path to the navigation software here.

To open the Radio menu, press Radio on the first page of the main menu.

A short touch of the box next to the caption will activate the option. A check mark 🗸 will show you that the option is selected.

#### High-Cut

The high-cut function automatically converts the signal from stereo to mono.

#### TA = Traffic Announcement

If this option is activated, traffic announcements are automatically imported into the running program. With a popup menu you have the option to turn off the traffic news or continue listening. Set the value by how many volume levels the radio should be louder.



#### Radio Text

If you have activated this function, information from the radio station can be transmitted to the radio. Such as information about the currently playing song or station program, as well as the station name.

#### AF = Alternative frequency

When AF is activated, the radio automatically switches to another frequency with better reception.




#### Auto

The radio always switches to a radio station, which currently promises the best reception, even if a regional program is interrupted.

#### Manual:

With a manual alternative frequency setting, the radio switches only to alternative frequencies of the current station with an identical regional program.

#### **DAB+** settings



#### Seamless Service Function

As soon as this function is activated, the radio automatically switches from DAB+ to FM, if the reception for DAB + is not sufficient. As soon as the reception is back, the radio automatically returns to DAB+.

Note: Due to technical reasons, this can lead to short sound interruptions due to a small time offset during switching.

#### Favorite Stations Clean

Resets all stored station memories.

## DISC/DVD

Insert a CD or DVD in the drive. After loading the media, the movie starts playing or the start menu of the movie is displayed.

To eject the CD/DVD, press the eject button  $\blacktriangle$  on the front of the device.

If you do not want to eject the media, but want to return to the previous menu, briefly press the MENU button on the front of the device.

#### Phone pairing

To access the phone menu, press the phone key on the sceen or the TEL key on the device.

To use the phone or Bluetooth feature, first connect your smartphone to the ESX device. Turn on the Bluetooth option on your smartphone and search for nearby devices. If your smartphone has completed the search, you should see the display ESX-VNC. Pair the smartphone with the device.

As soon as your smartphone has connected to the ESX device, you will also see this visually.



No connection in the upper left corner and gray icons in the lower left corner indicate that the device is not connected to a smartphone.



When the connection is established, you will see the name of the smartphone in the top left corner. The upper right corner shows the battery status and signal strength.

The icons for the phone book and the favorites are displayed at the bottom left.


Once connected, the smartphone automatically connects when Bluetooth is turned on and the smartphone is within range of the device.

You can pair two smartphones with the device. The smartphone that first connected to the device works through the device's hands free.

If the phone list is full and a third smartphone is to be paired, one smartphone must first be deleted from the phone list. These settings can be made via the settings icon.

First connect an iPod to a free USB port on the device. Use only USB cables approved by Apple<sup>®</sup>. Otherwise, it may cause malfunction or your iPod will not be recognized by the device. You can only access the menu if you have connected an iPod to the device via the USB port.

To access the iPod function, press **iPod** in the menu.

After pressing the iPod key, the start screen will be displayed and the contents of the iPod will be loaded. Depending on the size and amount of data, this may take a few seconds. After all required information has been called up, the playback interface appears on the screen.

You can run almost any of the options on your screen as you would expect from your iPod.





## USB & SD

To access the USB or SD menu, press USB or SD on the screen. You can only access the respective menu if you have also connected an SD card or USB stick to the device. Insert the SD card only into the upper SD card slot on the front of the unit.

Use only card and sticks formatted with FAT32. Otherwise, it may happen that the media can not be read. The connected USB or SD medium should not exceed 64 GB storage capacity.

After pressing the respective keypad, the start screen is called up and the content of the connected card or stick is loaded. Depending on the size and amount of data, this may take a few seconds.









## <u>Note:</u> Before you carry start the firmware update, first quit the navigation and remove the navigation SD card from your device.

In the menu INFO you will find some information about your device and the possibility to update the software.



To start the firmware update, you must go to the menu INFO. This menu is located on the last page of the main menu.

Make sure that there is a constant voltage supply during an update process. Power failures or voltage fluctuations may cause the update process to be disrupted and render the unit unusable.

Only use storage media which are 100% correct. If an error occurs on an SD card or a defect in the card, may result in an update error and the device will be damaged.

Only use updates for the VNC1045-DBJ that have been approved by ESX.

Use an SD card for a firmware update. This SD card must be formatted FAT32 and there should be no additional data on the SD card.

Insert the SD card into the upper SD card slot.

Now press the button Upgrade Now.



Only when the correct files are on the SD card the process will be executed.



If the device has detected the software, the device is restarted and the update is applied. The green dot above the arrow of the "Upgrade Now" button indicates that the update can be carried out and the system has recognized the software.

During the update you will see a progress bar. When it reaches 100%, the device will be restarted.

## VOICE CONTROL

The voice control icon activates SIRI (Apple) or Google Voice (Android) on your smartphone. Then you can retrieve all the commands of the respective operating system as usual and have them played back on the ESX device. For example, make calls.



To activate voice control, press the microphone icon found in the three main menus on the upper left screen.

#### Note:

Please note that this function requires an existing internet connection of the paired smartphone. Depending on the manufacturer and model, you may also need to install an app and make some settings there. Not all smartphone models are supported for this feature.

## TV & DVBT2

The device allows you to add other accessories such as a compatible DVBT2 tuner. This allows you to playback digital TV through the device if it has been correctly connected.




A connected DVBT2 can be enabled in the main menu via the "TV" button.

All you need is a micro SD card to transfer the logos. It must be formatted in FAT16/32 format and should not exceed a storage capacity of 64GB.


#### Proceed as follows:

- 1. Search for radio stations on your device and save as memory. Then sort the stations according to your wishes and note the position of the stations. E.g. BBC1 to memory FM1 or DAB1.
- 2. Insert an SD card into the computer. You may need a USB SD card adapter to do this.
- Download the logos of the radio stations you want to use. These can be found on the homepage of the radio stations or on the Internet.
- 4. These files are not provided by ESX.
- Note the file size that the images do not exceed an aspect ratio of 122 x 92px. You may need to edit the images to resize them. The files must be saved in .jpg/.bmp or .png format.
- Now change the name of the logos to FM1 (DAB1) to FM15 (DAB15) or AM1 to AM15. Make sure that they
  are capitalized in the file name. The file name is then the same for the station memory.
- For example, you have stored the station BBC1 on memory FM1. Save then the radio station logo of BBC1 with the file name FM1. Then, the device can recognizes which logo must be displayed on each memory.
- If you have done this with all of the desired channels, insert the SD card into the upper SD card slot in your ESX device.
- 9. Note: Do not use the lower SD card slot of the navigation software!
- 10. After inserting the SD card, the information is retrieved and the logos are displayed. Note that as soon as you remove the card, the logos can no longer be displayed.
- 11. If you change the order of the radio stations in the station memory, the logos may not be assigned correctly. Then sort the channel logos on the SD card in the correct order.



#### A: 1. Out of memory

Turn off the device and remove the Navi SD card. Connect the card to your PC and delete the complete SAVE folder (MobileNavigator - save). The folder is automatically created after the new configuration.

#### 2. Fatal Error

If you made a backup of the software after you purchased it, then format the SD card to FAT32 and play the backup again. If you have not made a backup, contact us.

#### 3. The mobileavigator.exe file displays an error:

## F: I hear no navigation announcements, although in the navigation settings the volume control for the announcements is turned on:

A: Go to the audio settings of the device and make sure that the fader **NAVI** has a certain minimum volume (see page 49).
