



Indiana Line Nota 2 and Nota 7 – loudspeaker set (center + bookshelf speakers)

This set is tailored for home theater enthusiasts. It comprises two compact, two-way Nota 2 bookshelf loudspeakers, which excel as surround channels, and the perfectly matched Nota 7 two-way center channel loudspeaker. This configuration delivers not only exceptional dynamics and transient precision but, above all, pristine reproduction of dialogue and vocal performances. An additional acoustic benefit comes from the rear-firing bass-reflex ports, which naturally enhance low-frequency extension, guaranteeing a truly cinematic experience in the comfort of your home.

Modern design and universal elegance

The refreshed Nota series embodies a modern, minimalist design aesthetic that seamlessly integrates into any space. The rigid MDF cabinets are finished with meticulous attention to detail. Their side panels feature a -quality vinyl wrap, available in elegant shades of black and classic oak, while the remaining surfaces are treated with a scratch-resistant matte black coating. Gently contoured cabinet edges provide the enclosures with a sense of visual lightness, creating a timeless and harmonious appeal. The front baffle aesthetic is further enhanced by custom trim rings that conceal the driver mounting hardware.

Optimized acoustic drivers

Carefully engineered two-way acoustic arrays are responsible for the loudspeakers' sonic coherence and high-fidelity output. Articulate high frequencies are delivered by 26mm textile dome tweeters, equipped with neodymium magnet systems, radial damping chambers, and custom waveguides designed to optimize acoustic dispersion within the listening room. The critical mid-bass frequencies – essential for home theater applications – are handled by 120mm cones. Formulated from a mica-polypropylene blend proven in the premium Tesi series, these cones, combined with refined surrounds, yield high precision, low distortion, and an exceptionally articulate midrange.

Advanced engineering and seamless receiver integration

From a technological standpoint, the Nota 2 and Nota 7 exemplify thoughtful acoustic engineering. The interiors of the cabinets are internally damped with polyester fiber to effectively eliminate unwanted cabinet resonance. Oversized ferrite motor systems in the newly developed mid-bass drivers ensure tight control over the lower registers, while the fully redesigned crossover networks – featuring air-core inductors

in the tweeter filter – guarantee a linear frequency response and smooth reproduction of trebles. Equally important, the friendly impedance curve of these loudspeakers makes the entire package remarkably easy to drive. As a result, it pairs seamlessly with virtually any AV receiver, delivering ad, versatile, and highly engaging soundstage.
